Feast of Tabernacles



- In Jesus' time, two ceremonies of water and light were part of the last day of Sukkot.
- A priest carried water from the pool of Siloam to the temple, symbolizing that when Messiah comes the whole earth will know God "as the waters cover the sea" (Isaiah 11:9).



Feast of Tabernacles



- When Jesus attended the Feast of Tabernacles, on the last day, he said, “If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me ...streams of living water will flow from within him” (John 7:37–38).
