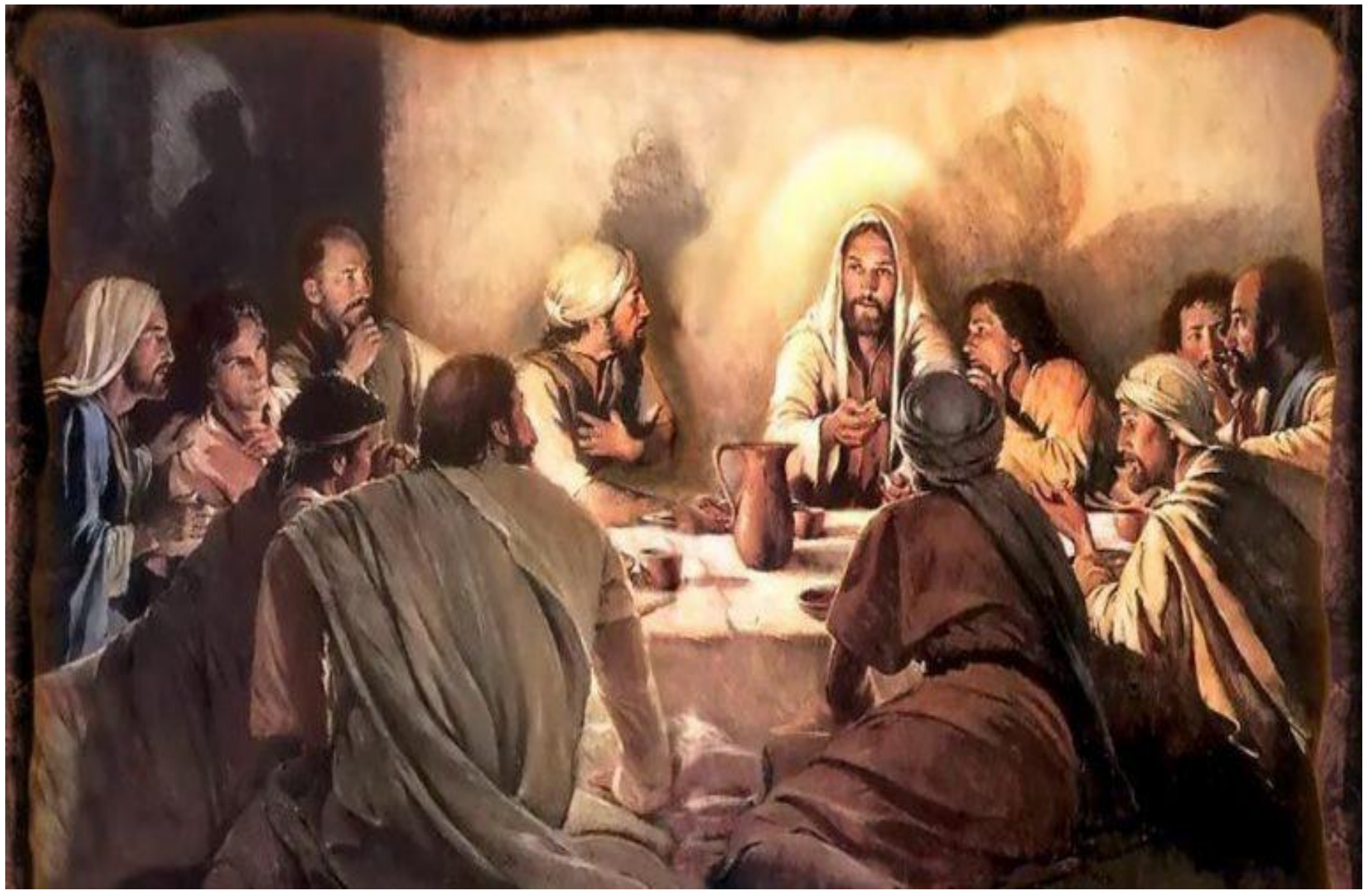

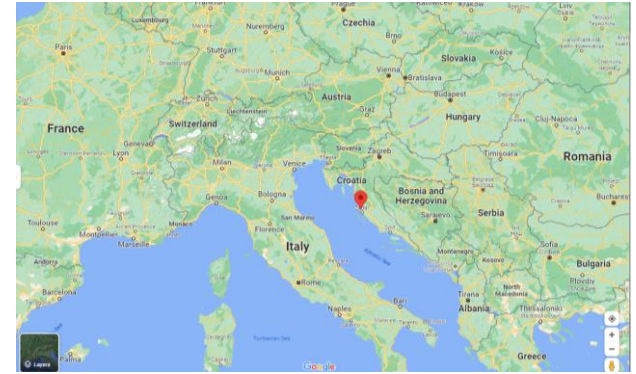

Jesus celebrating Passover with His disciples

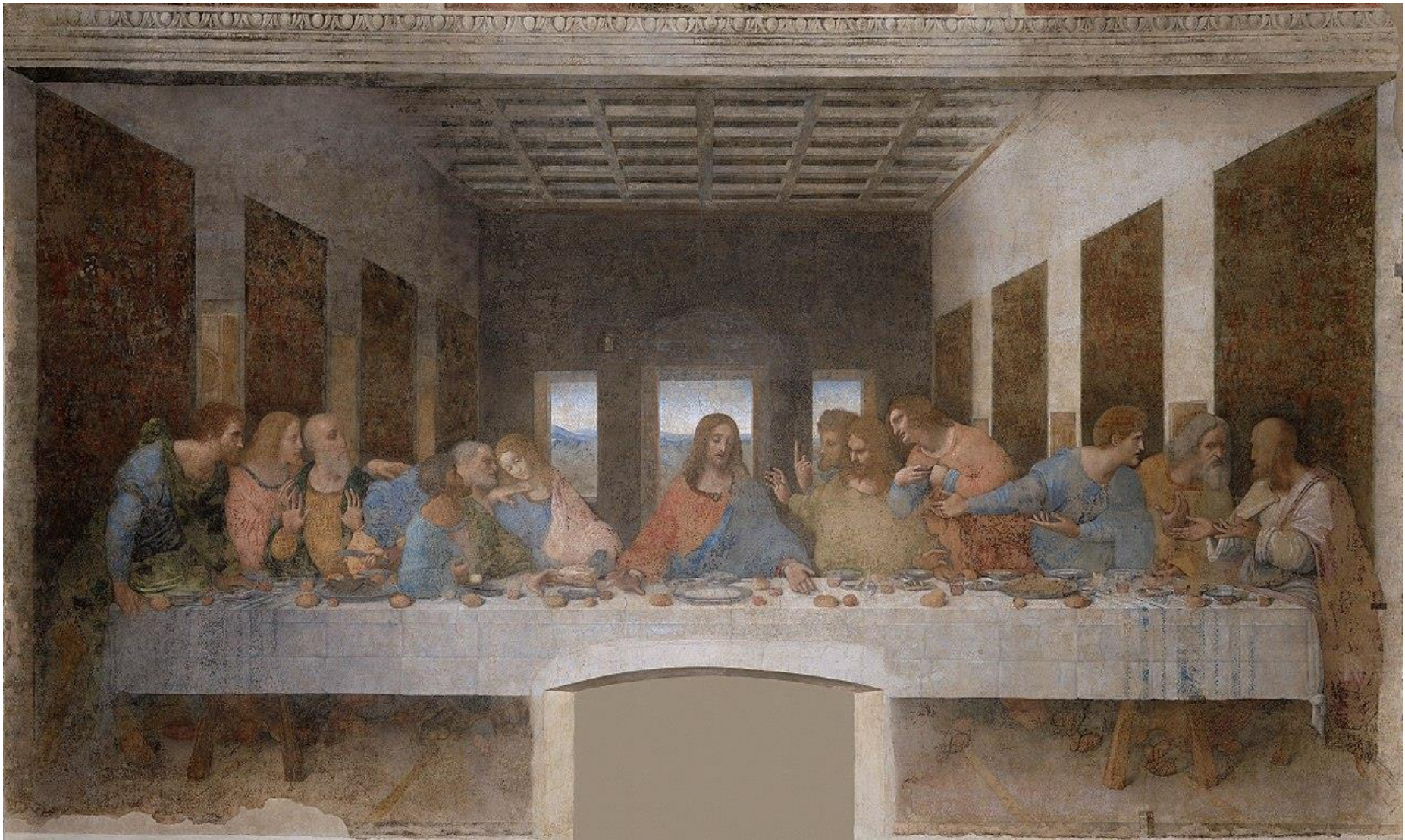


Jesus washes His disciples feet



One of the 30 silver coins that Judas received for betraying Jesus is kept in Nin, Croatia in the parish church of St. Asela.

The 'Judas' coin is 18.5 millimeters in diameter and made of silver. The front of the coin is filled with the head of the god Helium.

Haggadah (instructions)

The Cleaning of leaven (chametz).

The Lighting of the candles.

1. **Kadesh** (sanctification of the day and first cup of wine)
2. **Urchatz** (handwashing with no blessing)
3. **Karpas** (eating the green vegetable - parsley)
4. **Yachatz** (breaking the middle matzo – unleavened bread)
5. **Maggid** (4 questions and Exodus story listing 10 plagues and lamb bone (zeroah) and second cup of wine)
6. **Rachtzah** (handwashing with a blessing)
7. **Motzi** (blessing before eating matzo)
8. **Matzo** (eating the matzo)
9. **Maror** (eating the bitter herb - horseradish)
10. **Korech** (eating the choroseth – apple salad)
11. **Shulchan Orech** (eating the meal – egg (baytsah), gefilte fish, matzo-ball soup, beetroot salad, chopped liver)
12. **Tzafun** (eating the afikomen – broken piece of matzo – Luke 22:19)
13. **Barech** (blessing after eating and third cup of wine - Matthew 26:28) and search for Elijah)
14. **Hallel** (songs of praise and fourth cup of wine)
15. **Nirtzah** (conclusion - prayer)
