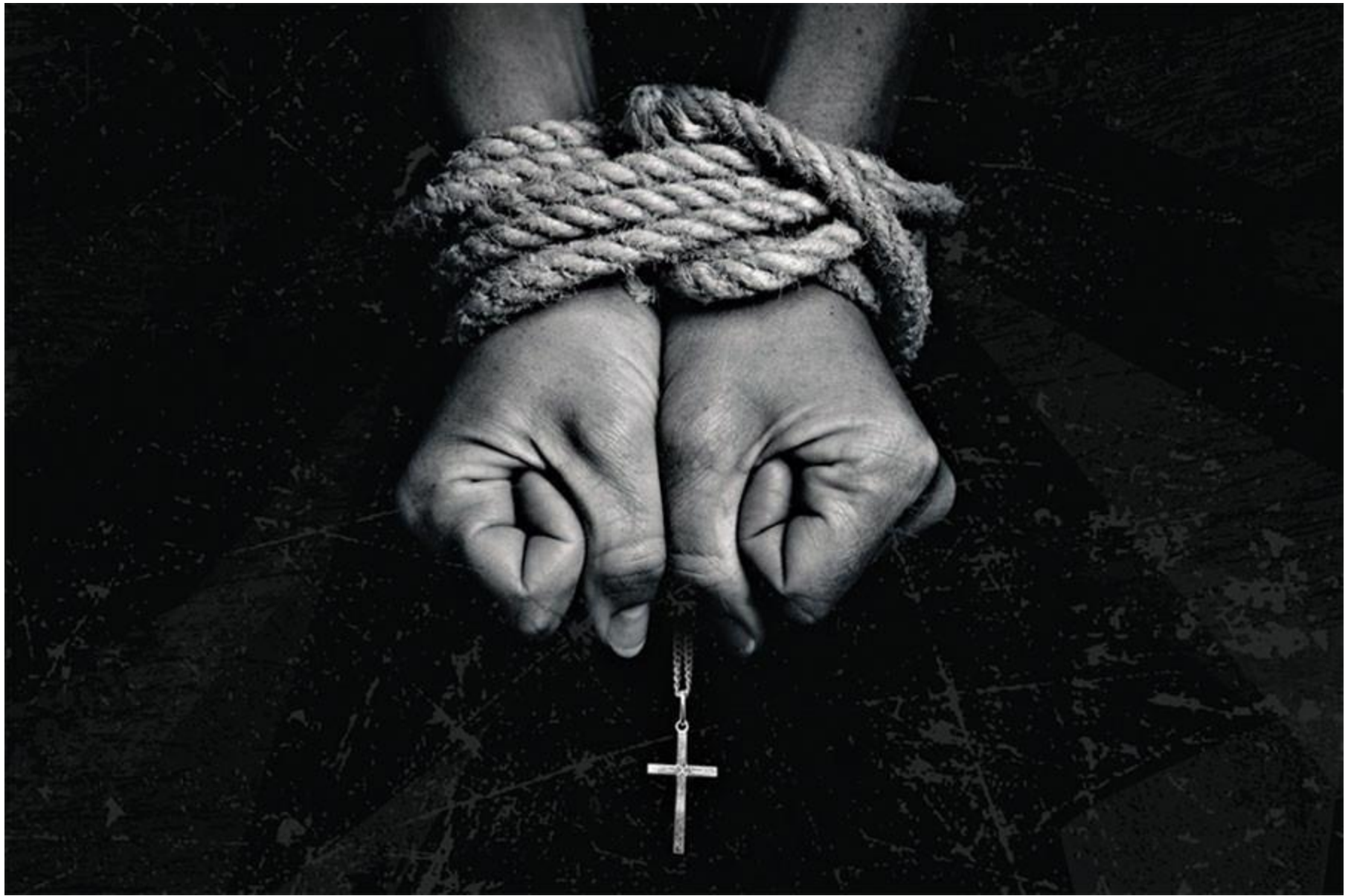

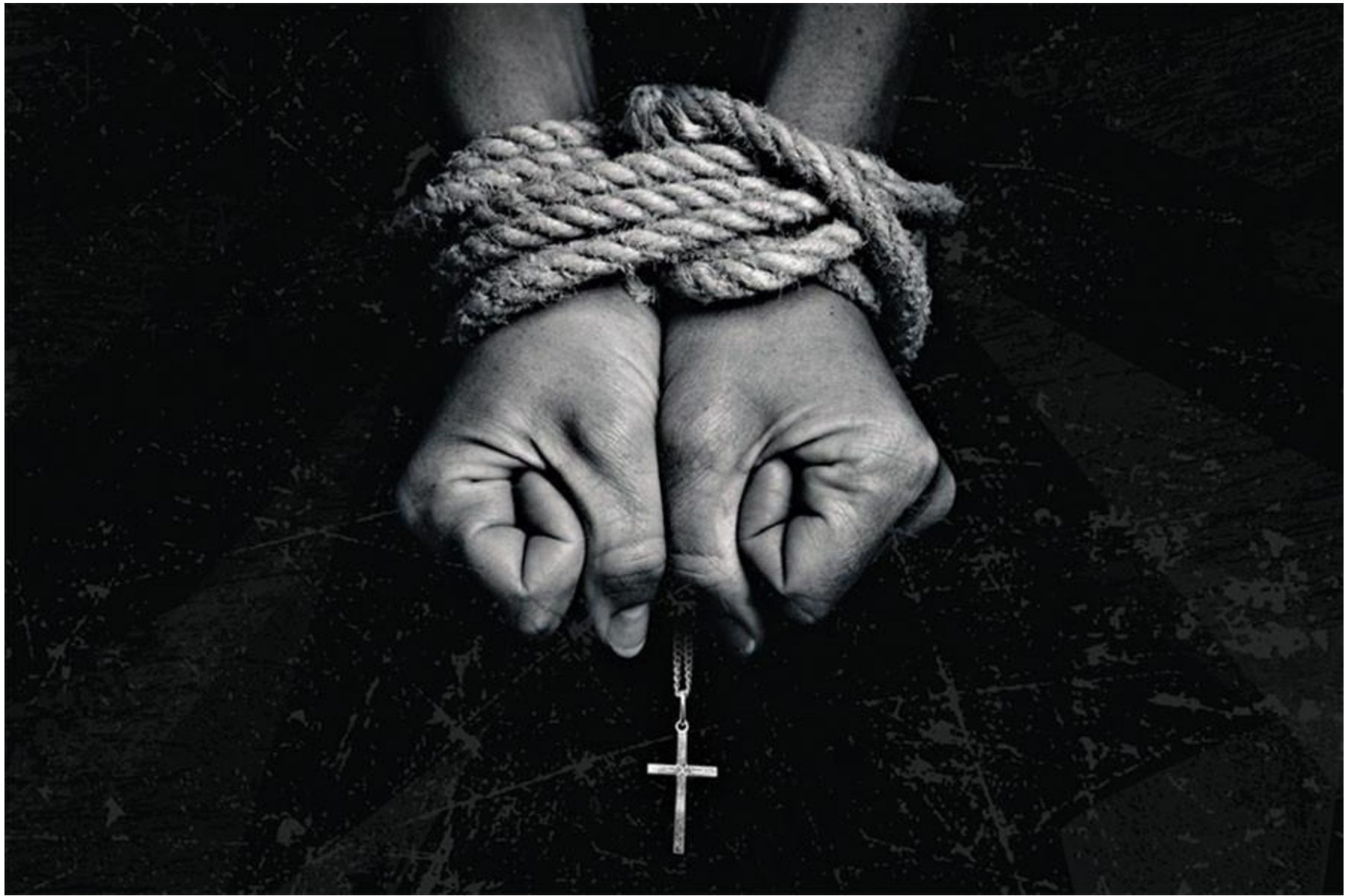

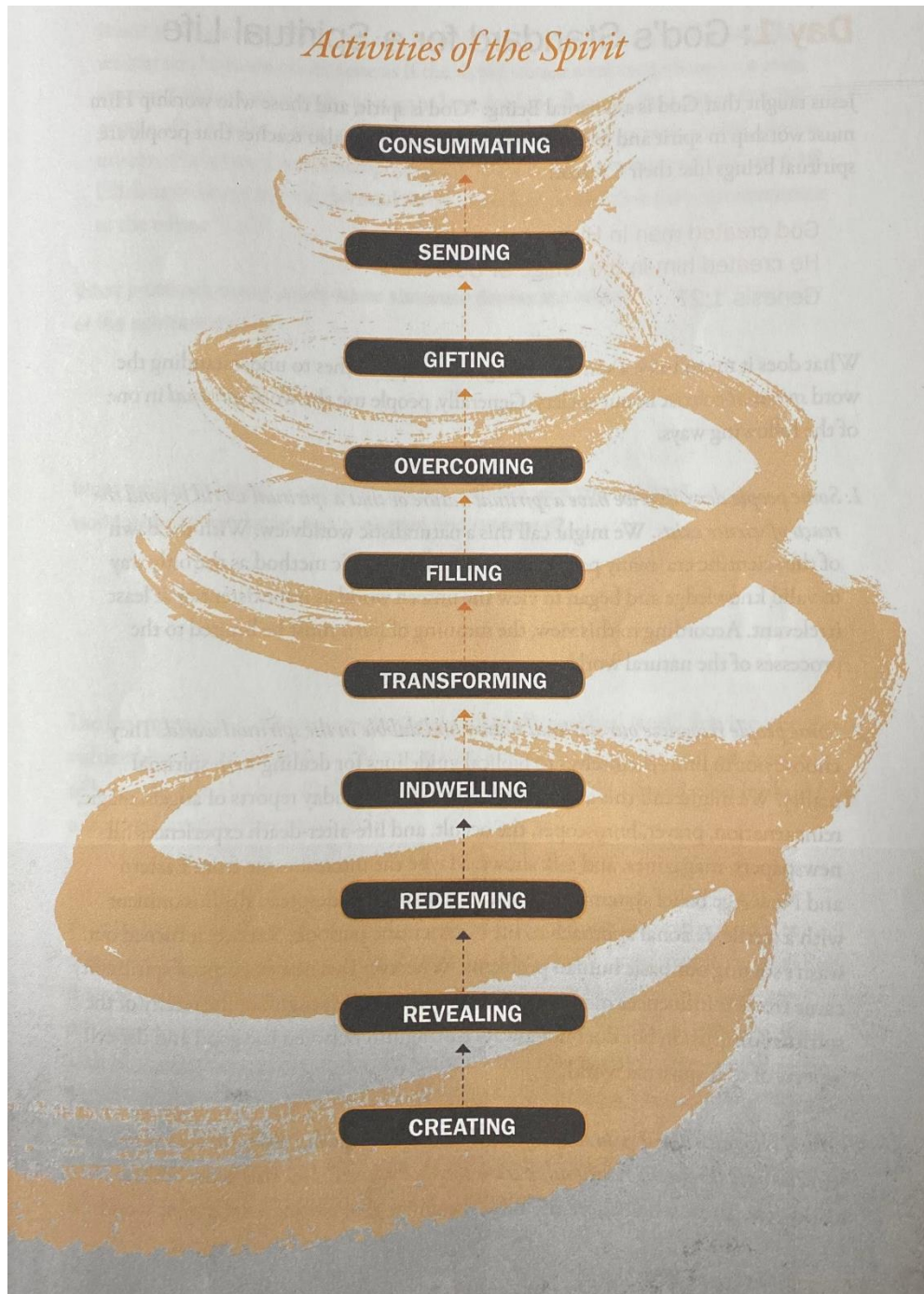

APPLICATION

- 1. Expect opposition and persecution as Christians.
Why? Because we are with Christ. You are identified with Christ.**
- 2. When sharing your faith, stay on the key issue which is: Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit is convicting them of their sin of unbelief, their unrighteousness, and the coming judgment. Some will believe, and some won't.**
