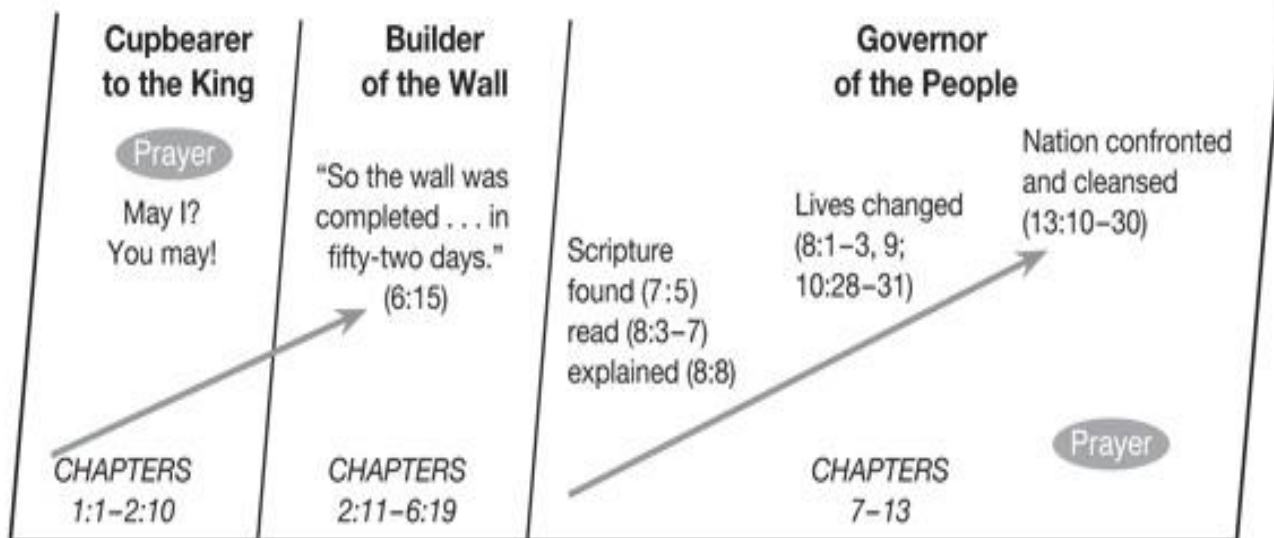

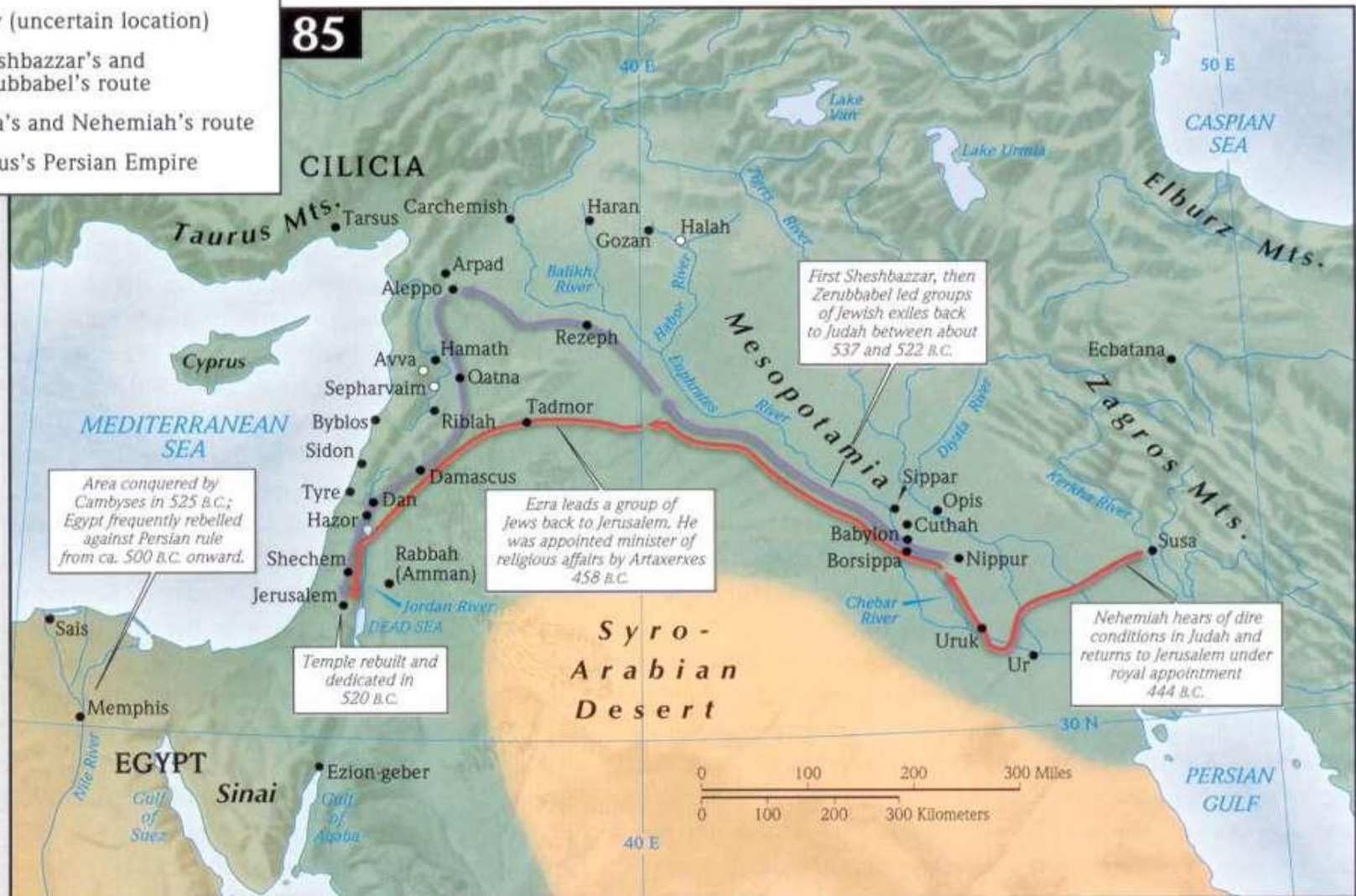
Persian King Artaxerxes 1
(reigned 464BC-423BC)

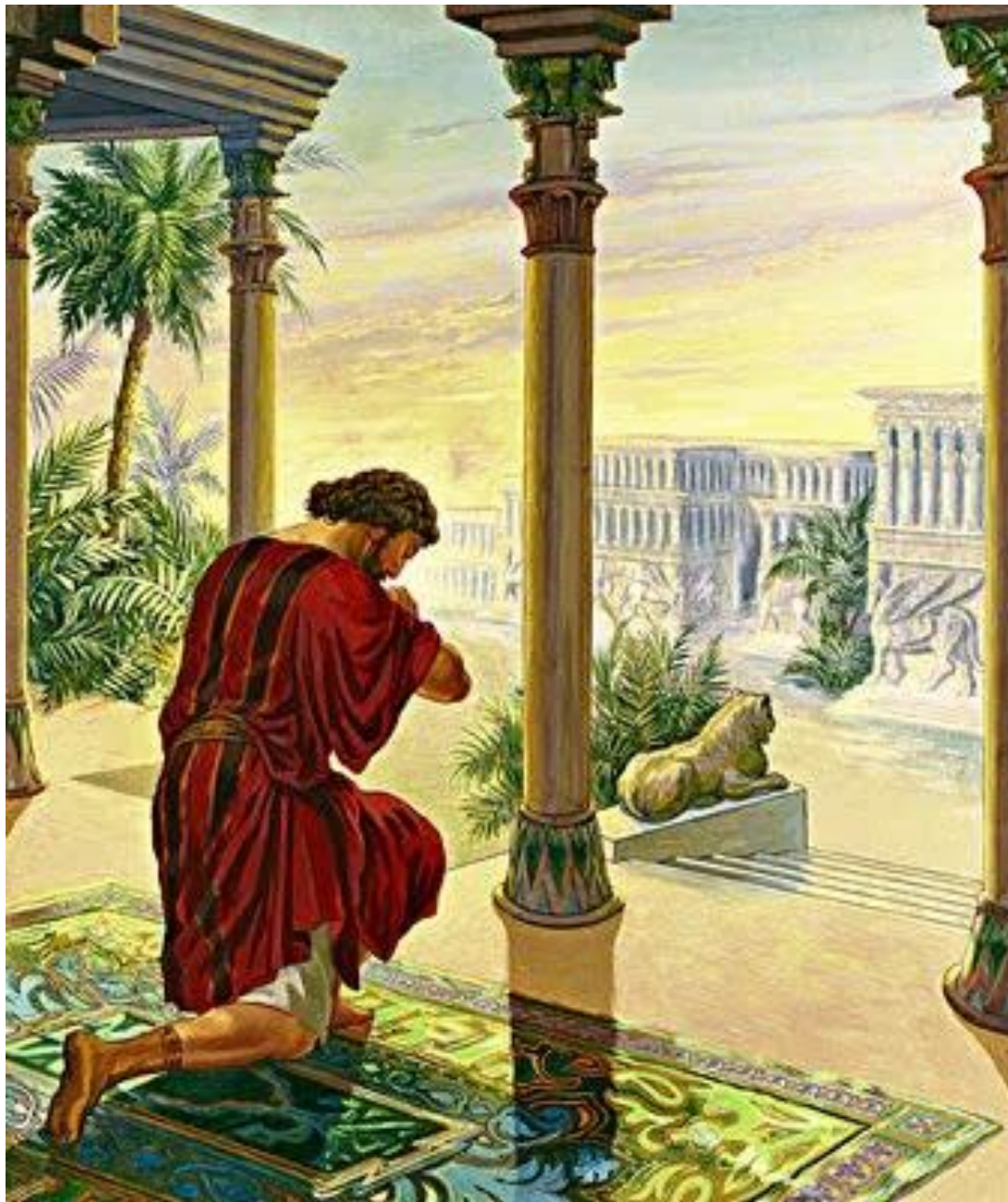
THE RETURNS OF JEWISH EXILES TO JUDAH
