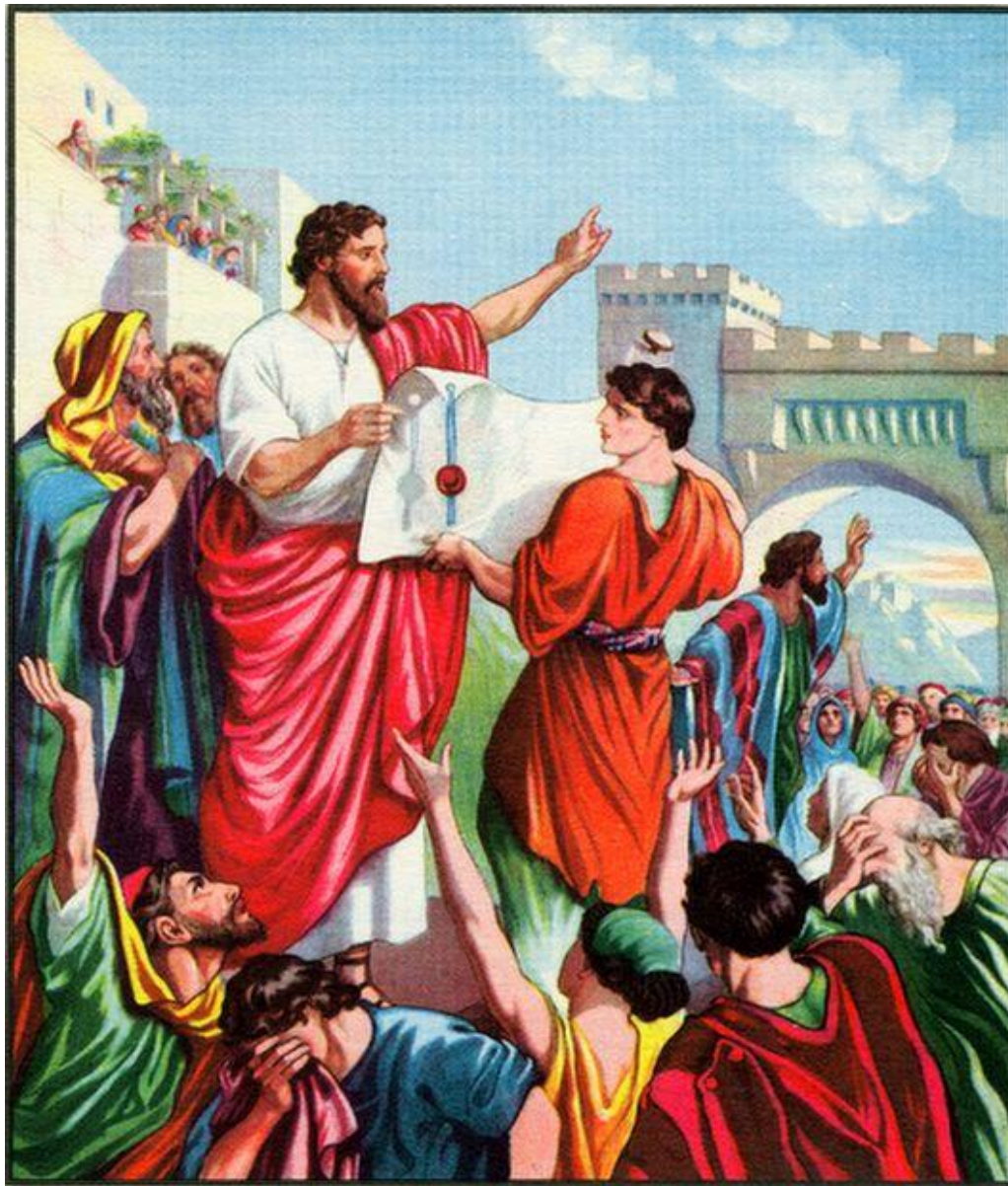

Nehemiah overseeing the rebuilding the walls and gates



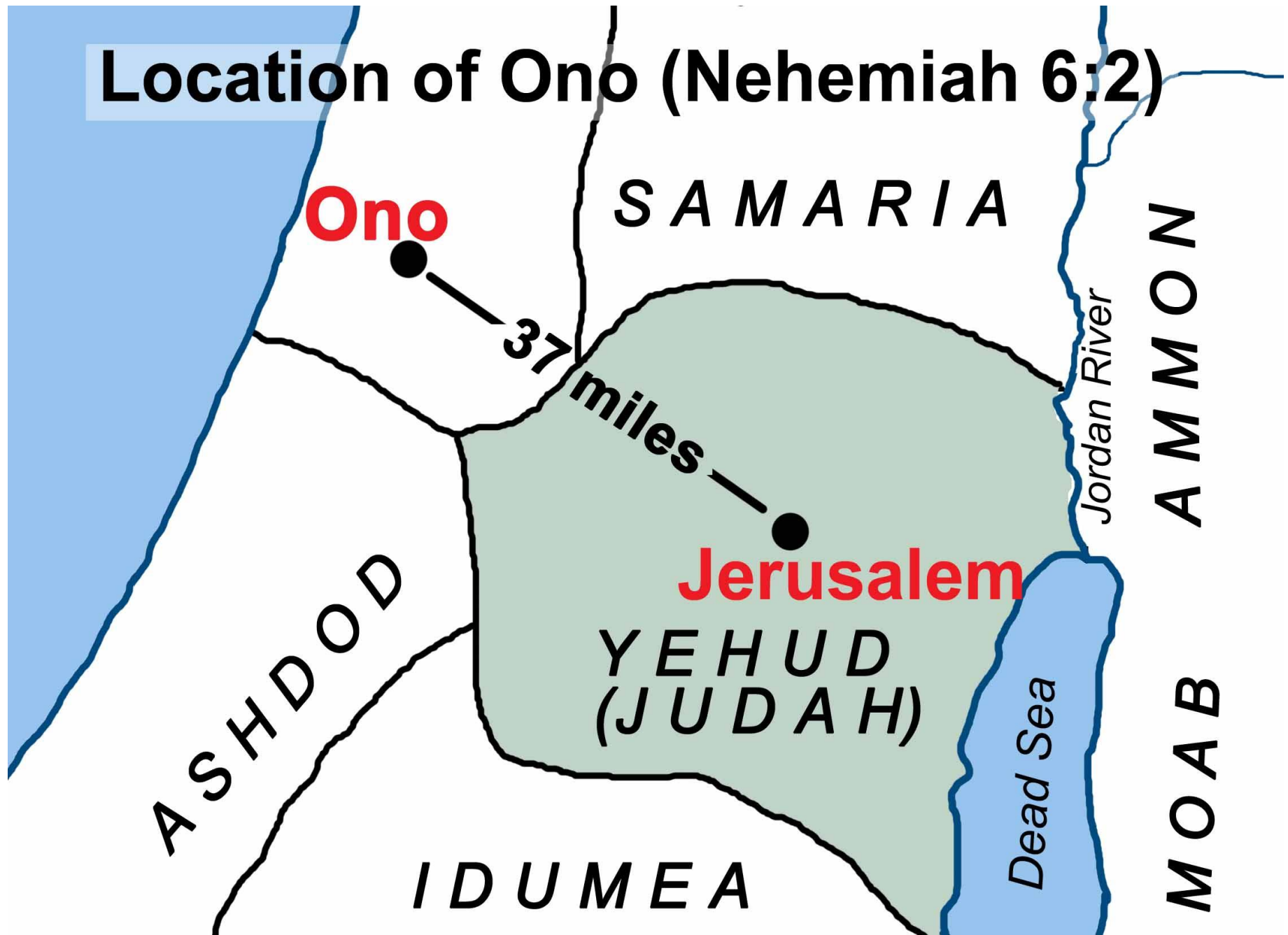
Nehemiah is appointed by the Persian King Artaxerxes 1

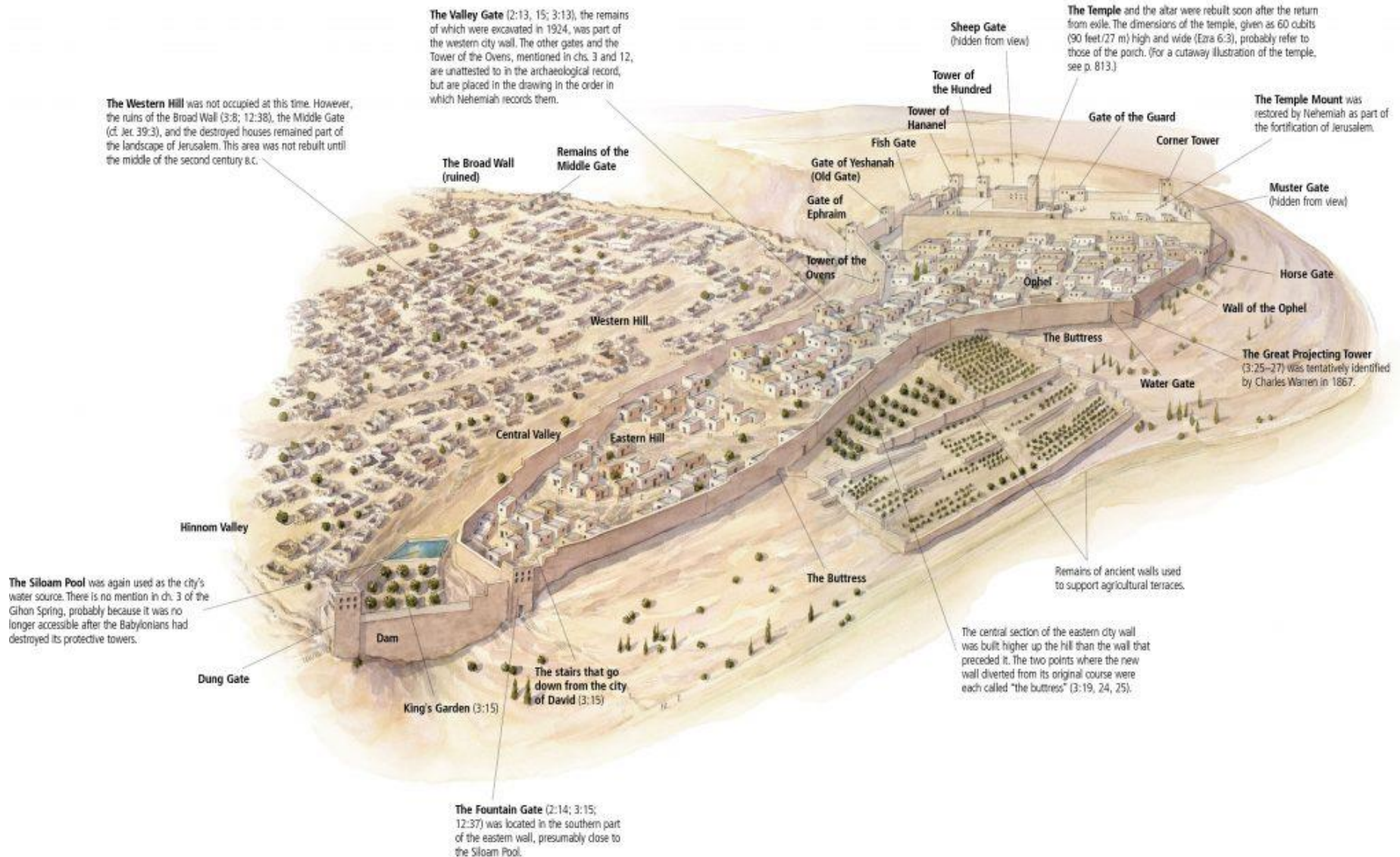
